CLINICAL TRIAL OF AYURVEDIC DRUG U-144 (K4 TABLETS) IN URINARY TRACT INFECTIONS

51 cases of clinically diagnosed patients of Urinary Tract Infection, including 31 patients with positive laboratory investigations were treated with an Ayurvedic drug U 144B. They were administered placebo tablets (U-144A) for a fortnight followed by the actual drug (U-144B) and followed up every fortnight for two months. It was observed that -

- 1. U-144A had no effect at all.
- 2. U-144B showed a very good effect clinically by the end of the first month and early complete remission except in 3 cases, though the culture remained positive in the majority of cases.
- 3. U-144B did not show any side effects even when used for a long period of two months.
