

# **A PRELIMINARY CONTROLLED CLINICAL TRIAL OF INDIGENOUS COMPOUND DRUG<sup>@</sup> IN CASES OF RHEUMATOID ARTHRITIS.**

The modern treatment of Rheumatoid Arthritis is mostly palliative. Certain indigenous drugs are suggested to be useful. Indigenous compound drugs, Rh-1A, Rh-1B and Rh-1 (Au) were tried clinically. In this controlled clinical trial Rh-1B is found to have moderate degree of anti-arthritic effect in sub acute cases of Rheumatoid Arthritis. Rh-1 (Au) is found to be useful in Acute Rheumatism. Further extended trials are suggested.
